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| Class Meetings | Seminar meets once a week during a specified period in the REACH Classroom. Seminar students meet 1:1 with me at least twice per quarter regarding their progress and goals. Weekly attendance is a PARTICIPATION GRADE. | |
| | MISSED CLASS MEETINGS: Students are responsible for emailing/texting me BEFORE class if they are going to be absent. Students may make-up a missed class meeting within one week for full credit. Missed classes without prior notification and 1:1 make-up meeting will receive 50% credit. | |

ATTENDANCE AND ENGAGEMENT

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<u>ATTENDANCE</u>: Due to the advanced nature of this class, attendance is critical to student success. It is the student's responsibility to engage consistently in our class meetings. Weekly attendance/engagement is a PARTICIPATION GRADE. In the event that an absence is **unavoidable**:

- Email/text me PRIOR to the absence.
- Schedule a 1:1 make-up meeting with me within one week.
- Review/complete class information/assignments.
- Long-term assignment DUE DATES are firm and should be met on time. In case of an emergency, the student should contact me to work out a reasonable resolution.
- Parents will be notified if the student's passing grade for the class is in jeopardy.

<u>ENGAGEMENT</u>: Honors Seminar fosters adulting skills and mindsets for the marketplace beyond high school. As such, I expect:

- students to represent the Amphitheater School District in a professional manner, especially when interacting with allies, mentors and interviewees;
- students to practice professionalism in appearance, attitude and conduct;
- students to contribute consistently and authentically to our classroom community
- students to demonstrate respect, dignity and integrity for themselves, each other, and their instructors/allies/mentors

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<u>GRADES:</u> Grades are calculated on a 10% scale: 90% + = A, 89-80% = B, 79-70% = C, 69-60% = D, 59% and below = F. Final grades are based on points accumulated in the following weighted categories:

*Late assignments are subject to 10% point deduction per day late , starting <u>1 week</u> <u>after the assigned due date</u>. Students can avoid point deductions by communicating with me <u>before</u> due dates and working out a reasonable resolution.

Assignments **not turned in will receive 50% credit per district policy.
