STEPS

- 1. ISSUES (What is the problem?)
- 2. INTERESTS (Why is it a problem?)
- 3. OPTIONS (How might we solve it?)
- 4. STANDARDS (How shall we evaluate the options?)
- 5. JUDGE OPTIONS WITH STANDARDS
