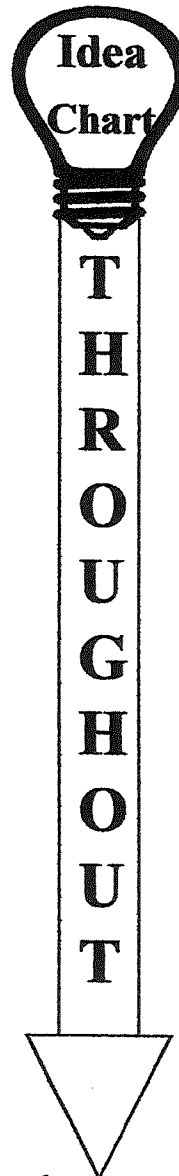


Interest-Based Problem-Solving PROCESS

STEPS

1. ISSUES
(What is the problem?)
2. INTERESTS
(Why is it a problem?)
3. OPTIONS
(How might we solve it?)
4. STANDARDS
(How shall we evaluate the options ?)
5. JUDGE OPTIONS WITH STANDARDS



GROUP PROCESS TECHNIQUE

- a. Identify Issue
- b. Discussion/Info Sharing
- c. Consensus/Agreement on the Issue
- a. Identify Interests
Separate and/or Mutual
- b. Discussion/Info Sharing
- c. Consensus on Mutual Interests
- a. Brainstorming
- a. Discussion and Consensus
on Standards to be used
- a. Discussion and Consensus
on which Option to use
