2. As you read, pay attention to the details in the illustrations for ideas for your puppet. What color hair does your character have? What kind of clothes does he or she wear?	
3. Collect items from around your house that you can use to make your puppet look interesting. You can glue on yarn or crêpe paper for hair, beads or buttons for eyes, and fabric scraps or colored paper for clothing. Construct your puppet the same way you made a puppet in class. Be sure to leave room for your puppet's mouth.
