IRHS SCHOLARS PROGRAM

- Students must successfully complete 12 Scholars courses and maintain a 3.5 weighted GPA
- Dual Enrollment, Honors, and AP courses have weighted grades and are considered Scholars courses
- ► IRHS Scholars are recognized with a cord worn at graduation

AP CLASSES

- Accelerated courses that offer a weighted HS grade and opportunity for college credit through end of year exam
- ▶ We have AP classes in all core subjects and electives!
- Some examples of AP classes: Calculus AB, Chemistry, English Literature, World History, Computer Science, Studio Art

DUAL ENROLLMENT CLASSES

- College level courses through Pima Community College
- Enroll as a PCC college student at the same time
- College credit awarded if you pass the class with a "C" or better
- Dual Enrollment offerings in all subjects as well: English Composition, College Algebra, Chemistry, United States History, Healthcare Foundations, Culinary Arts, and others
