

We are able to send one male student and one female student to represent Ironwood Ridge at Girls and Boys State this coming summer. This week long event hosts student leaders from across the state.






# IRHS SCHOLARS PROGRAM

- ▶ Students must successfully complete 12 Scholars courses and maintain a 3.5 weighted GPA
  - ▶ Dual Enrollment, Honors, and AP courses have weighted grades and are considered Scholars courses
  - ▶ IRHS Scholars are recognized with a cord worn at graduation
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# AP CLASSES

- ▶ Accelerated courses that offer a weighted HS grade and opportunity for college credit through end of year exam
  - ▶ We have AP classes in all core subjects and electives!
  - ▶ Some examples of AP classes: Calculus AB, Chemistry, English Literature, World History, Computer Science, Studio Art
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# DUAL ENROLLMENT CLASSES

- ▶ College level courses through Pima Community College
  - ▶ Enroll as a PCC college student at the same time
  - ▶ College credit awarded if you pass the class with a "C" or better
  - ▶ Dual Enrollment offerings in all subjects as well: English Composition, College Algebra, Chemistry, United States History, Healthcare Foundations, Culinary Arts, and others
