# A Note from our Principal

Dear Parents,

I'm happy to report that the implementation of our "On Time Club" is starting to work! We have been trying very hard to get our students to be in their seats by 7:30 at the very latest, and for some classes, it is paying off! Your child's class earns one letter per day in which all of the students are present and on time. Congratulations to Ms. Franklin's class (they have won twice!), Ms. Stocker's class, Ms. Jimmerson's class and Ms. Brungardt's class who have all spelled out the words "On Time Club". Students in these classes have all earned popsicle parties for coming to school every day and for being on time.

If you drop your children off for school in the mornings, <u>please plan to be in the drop</u> <u>off zone by 7:20 a.m</u>. This will ensure that your child has enough time to get out of your car, cross to the sidewalk and walk to class. If you drop off any later than this, chances are that the student will be late. If a student is late to class, it prevents the whole class from earning a letter for the "On Time Club" challenge.

Absences are also a concern. Last year, as a whole school, our students were absent 7.69% of the time. This equates to approximately 2,830 school days missed by our students. As we all know, children can't learn if they are not in class, so we have set a goal to improve our attendance rate from 92.9% to at least 93.4%. As you can see, we desperately need your help in getting our kids to school on time. I can't tell you how much we appreciate the efforts you make to get your children here to school on time – it truly does make a huge difference when they are here every day and are on time.



## **REACH/Gifted Testing**


