Information About Student Absences

We have new Arizona Department of Education guidelines regarding student absences. Please take a few minutes to read these guidelines:

- According to <u>ARS 15-901(A)</u>, all absences in excess of 10% of instructional days (18 days) whether excused or unexcused, must be marked as <u>UNEXCUSED</u> after the 18 days.
- PARENTS MUST ACCOMPANY THEIR CHILD for a late entry or early exit to be excused. If the
 parent is not with the student, it will ALWAYS be marked as UNEXCUSED regardless of the circumstance. ARS 15-803
- DOCTOR/DENTAL NOTES MUST BE GIVEN TO THE OFFICE TO BE EXCUSED. If a student is leaving
 early for the day due to a doctor's appointment, please send your child with their note the following
 day. ARS 15-901

Also please remember that to sign your child out in the office if you are checking him/her out early. Please do not go directly to the classroom. Thank you very much for your help with absences.

We do not allow children to be signed out after 2:15pm unless it has been prearranged.



A friendly reminder...

Please refrain from having lengthy conversations with your child's teacher when you drop your child off to school. Teachers are happy to communicate with parents but are not able to do so effectively when the students are arriving at class. Please schedule an appointment with your child's teacher for after school if you have an important matter to discuss. Thank you so much!
