



Spending by operational area








Changes in operational spending percentages




Total operational and instructional spending per pupil (inflation adjusted to 2016 dollars)


English Language Learner (ELL) Services – Student Enrollment




Country of Birth for ELL Students – 2016-17



Reclassified Rate of ELL Students, by School of Enrollment – 2016-17





Teacher Turnover Rate & Reason Given for Leaving






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Enrollment on the 100th Day






Average Daily Attendance – 1st through 100th Day






Average Daily Attendance – Year-End


MAP Fall to Spring Growth: Elementary School

Average Number of RIT Points Above Expected Growth **Mathematics**






Average Number of RIT Points Above Expected Growth **Reading** Fall 2016-Spring 2017






Arizona English Language Learner Assessment (AZELLA) Growth - 2016-17



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Graduation Rate: By School and Special Program Membership





Advanced Placement Testing: 5-year Trends







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
Mobility Rate










